**Example [1]** The Grupo de Teatro Popular Realista were founded by Alfonso Sastre.

**[2]** Alfonso Sastre, who is one of Spain's leading playwrights, have been influenced by the works of Arthur Miller.

**[3]** Some of his writing show the influence of Brecht and Beckett. **[4]** Sastre, along with these playwrights, usually

place his plays in urban locations. [5] A major theme throughout his plays are criticism of society. [6] Despair caused by social injustices pervade Sastre's works. [7] The characters in almost every play face the problem of maintaining a sense of self. [8] Overcrowded living conditions, in addition to situations often demeaning, adds to the characters' misery. [9] However, he, as well as Miller, inject a sense of hope into the despair. [10] Perhaps the play that stands as the finest example of the theme of despair and hope are *Ana Kleiber*. [11] This playwright, who is considered one of Spain's most controversial dramatists, have also been called his country's most original.
