- A. Summarize your main points in your speech
- B. Restatement of your thesis (**in bold**) – **copy and paste again**
- C. End with an appeal **leave your judges with a statement, additional thought, idea, etc. at end of speech**

Your outline should be typed in 12 point Times Roman font with 1" margins on all sides.
The outline can be as many pages as needed, it doesn't have to fit on one page!
